What is Generation STEAM?

The Generation STEAM program will increase the access of under-resourced students to a quality education that includes learning in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics). The project guides students to develop viable solutions to community problems solving both the community's needs and those of the kids.

What do volunteers do?

Arts Partners is seeking professionals and makers in Engineering, Computer Science, Architecture, Math, Art, Construction and other creative fields. Using their industry knowledge and technical skills, volunteers visit a classroom to give feedback on student designs and assist with prototypes or judge a student competition at least once for one hour. Volunteer orientation is provided.

Arts Partners will match you up with students to guide them from "Big Idea" to a viable solution to a community problem. Volunteers are also a representative of their field, potentially the first person the student has met with a job in that industry.
